

Thank you for your interest in the Governor Mario M. Cuomo Bridge Shared Use Path (“the Path”). During its inaugural season, the Path provided a new trans-Hudson connection for more than 250,000 cyclists and pedestrians. The Path, with its six scenic overlooks, offers an exciting and unique recreational experience. Public amenities at either end include restrooms, parking and public art.

The New York State Thruway Authority (NYSTA) is inviting qualified local vendors to provide non-alcoholic beverages, ready to eat food products and bicycle rental services over the course of two years at the Westchester and Rockland Landings. **Each vending season will run from the beginning of spring through October.** NYSTA is also offering vendors the option of providing refreshments at the Painters Point overlook, which is located at the mid-point of the Path.

Your proposal should include:

- Nature of your proposed business, including detailed list of variety of products and/or services being offered.
- Proposed landing(s)/overlook, amount of space needed for the size of the operation and staffing model.
- Detailed business background, experience, at least two references with contact information.
- Services must be provided at a minimum 5 days per 7-day week, including Saturday & Sunday, and during daylight hours. Longer hours of operation may be evaluated more favorably. Peak Path traffic occurs on average 10am and 2pm daily.

Please note:

- Only proposals that are submitted by the listed deadline will be considered.
- Sending a proposal does not guarantee acceptance into the program.
- Preference will be given to local vendors and approved participants of the Taste NY program through the NYS Dept. of Agriculture & Markets.
- If selected, vendors will need a NYS Thruway Authority seasonal permit and a fee will be required.
- All food, beverages and merchandise selling operations must conform in all respects to federal, state and municipal laws, ordinances, rules and regulations.
- A selection committee will evaluate each vendor proposal using the criteria listed above.

Proposals are due via email no later than February 12, 2021.

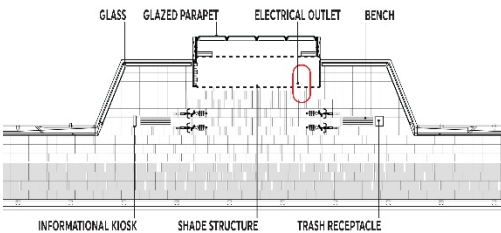

WESTCHESTER LANDING

THE WESTCHESTER LANDING IS LOCATED AT 333 SOUTH BROADWAY IN TARRYTOWN, NEXT TO THE NEW YORK STATE THRUWAY AUTHORITY MAINTENANCE FACILITY.

- Two (2) Truck Stalls, suitable for food trucks or trailers
- The first stall measures approximately 10' x 20', with a 16' sliding gate providing access to the public plaza
- The second stall measures approximately 10' x 24', with a 16' sliding gate providing access to the public plaza
- Each stall has access to electric outlets (208V, 3-phase, 40A)
- One (1) Pop-up/Tent location, measuring no greater than 6'x6', located within the plaza

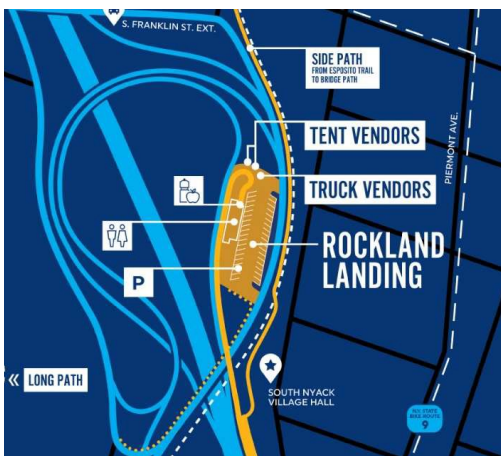


PAINTERS POINT OVERLOOK

PAINTERS POINT IS LOCATED AT THE MIDPOINT OF THE PATH (1.8 MILES IN) AND CAN ONLY BE ACCESSED BY FOOT OR BY BIKE, FROM EITHER THE ROCKLAND OR WESTCHESTER LANDING.



- Space is available for a portable, branded chiller, with access to an outlet in the location shown.
- Transport of supplies must not in any way impede pedestrian and / or bicycle traffic.
- Additional elements (e.g. umbrellas, signage) may be allowed at the overlook with the express approval of the Authority.



ROCKLAND LANDING

THE ROCKLAND LANDING IS LOCATED IN SOUTH NYACK, NESTLED WITHIN INTERCHANGE 10 OF THE THRUWAY. VISITORS ACCESS THE PARKING LOT FROM ROUTE 9W.

- One (1) Truck Stall, measuring approximately 10'x20', suitable for a food truck or trailer with access to electric outlets (208V, 3-phase, 40A)
- One (1) Pop-up/Tent location, measuring 6'x6', located adjacent to the Path
